Writing Exercise 英文訳例

- 1) Japan has won a non-permanent seat on the UN Security Council for the 11th time, the most among UN member countries. It will return to the body for the first time in five years.

- 2) Japan garnered 184 votes in the 193-nation assembly, far more than a two-thirds vote required for election. Japan's ambassador to the United Nations welcomed the election. He said the country will use its abundant experience to address the many challenges facing the international community.

- 3) Mr. Obama also announced on Thursday that the United States will have 5,500 troops in Afghanistan when he leaves office in January 2017. He said they will be stationed at a small number of bases. They will focus on counterterrorism operations and training Afghan forces.

- 4) The US-led coalition in Afghanistan ended its combat mission in late 2014. Mr. Obama said the Afghan security forces are not as strong as they need to be. He cited continued Taliban attacks and the emergence of the Islamic State militant group.

- 5) Mr. Obama said as Commander-in-Chief, he will not allow Afghanistan to be used as a safe haven for terrorists to attack the United States again.
